FALL 2024 DANCE CLASSES OFFERED (Days & Times TBD)

Creative Movement

This is the perfect 45 minute class for your young dancer ages 3 - 4 years. Students use gross motor and listening skills while improving balance, flexibility and coordination through a variety of upbeat songs.

Ballet/Tap Combo

60 min. combo classes are offered for pre-k - 3rd grade students. Ballet is the backbone of all dance, where poise, grace and overall body strength is gained through our Cecchetti method. In tap, students gain coordination, rhythm, balance and self-confidence.

Ballet /Tap/Jazz Combo

These 90 minute combo classes are offered for 4th grade – 12th grades. Adding jazz to the combo class lends a sense of style using cool moves to fun music.

Jazz

Fast pace style incorporating ballet techniques. 45 minutes for kdg-12th grade. Classes will be divided into age groups.

Hip Hop

Enjoy a fast pace style to age appropriate music. 45 min classes for 4th grade and up. All boys class available

Lyrical

Lyrical combines jazz and ballet styles and techniques to make a more interpretive style of dance done to slower music with words. 4th grades and up –classes will be divided into age groups if needed. 45 minutes.

Musical Theater

This 45 minute class is offered for 4th grade and up. Using jazz technique and Broadway music, students enjoy lip singing and acting while dancing!

Acro

Classes for ages 3-18. Work on flexibility, strength, balance, muscle control, and more. Basic tumbling skills such as forward rolls, cartwheels, walk-overs, aerols, handsprings, etc. will be practiced as students gain body control to allow them to progress

Tap Technique

45 minutes of junior or senior level tap technique is offered for students 4th grade and above. No recital dance, just work on skills!

Jazz Technique

Work on stretching, progressions, turns and leaps. No recital dance. 45 minutes.

Cecchetti Ballet Technique Grades I-V

Classes for students 4th grade and above to gain technique needed for all the disciplines of dance. Students are eligible to take a ballet exam. Students learn and perfect barre work, center floor and across the floor as well as stressing the French terms used for each exercise. No recital dance. Classes are generally 60 min.

PIANO & DANCE SOLOS

Students who take piano have a greater understanding of musicality in dance. A separate piano recital will be held for these students! Reserve your spot before it's taken! (Ask about summer lessons.) Dance solos based on seniority and **first come first serve. The office will contact you in the summer for availability and to set a class/day time. 30 minutes each**

COMPETITION TEAM CLASSES

2nd-12th grade; Students must be committed to compete to participate. Co-requisite technique classes are required. Applications are available at the studio or on our website to apply. Teams offered: lyrical, tap, jazz, ballet, hip hop, modern, musical theater, pom

Dress Rehearsal- Tuesday, June 4

This is a full dress rehearsal with costumes, lights and music. The PRIMARY purpose of dress rehearsal is to prepare students for the recital with as little confusion as possible. The students need to get used to their costumes, the stage and tempo of the recital. It is mandatory that all students attend dress rehearsal.

Unless a parent/guardian is signed up to help backstage, only one parent/guardian per student is permitted into the high school during dress rehearsal. NO EXCEPTIONS! Students have been given one dress rehearsal pass for their parent or guardian (enclosed). Videotaping and flash photography will be permitted during dress rehearsal only.

Parents will be allowed to do this on the second and third level of the cafetorium only. **Flash photography and videotaping will not be permitted during the recital.** Each recital will be uploaded to our website for you to view and download if you wish by Stearns Marketing. **Dress rehearsal is the student’s opportunity to see friends dance by sitting quietly on the lowest level. Dancers are not allowed to be in the audience during their recital.**

Dress Rehearsal will be broken into TWO different performance times

4:00 Doors open & 4:30-7:00 Rehearsal for the “A Show” performing in the Thursday evening and Saturday matinee shows. **This includes all student classes 2nd grade and younger and all team dancers and all soloists listed on the A Show line up

7:15-9:45 Rehearsal for the “B Show” performing in the Friday and Saturday evening shows; 3rd grade and above classes, all team dancers (EXCEPT PETITE), and all soloists listed on the B show lineup.

*If you are uncertain as to when your child will perform, please contact the studio. (Both soloists will perform back to back at rehearsal.)

Dressing rooms are provided to all performers during rehearsal & recital.

Parent volunteers (females) are needed to help in the dressing rooms during all shows. A sign-up poster board will be in the studio lobby soon!

DRESSING ROOM ASSIGNMENTS

“A SHOW” Thursday evening 7:00 pm & Saturday 3:30 pm Matinee Performers (Doors open at 6:30 & 3:00)

Signs will direct the following classes to individual dressing rooms: Creative movement, Pre-k, Kdg, 1st grade, 2/3rd, 4/5th. Band Room 6th-12th grade.

“B SHOW” 7:00 pm Friday and Saturday Performers (Doors open at 6:30)

Signs will direct you to dressing rooms: 3rd grade, 4th & 5th grade all together Band Room – All dancers 6th-12th.

Upon entering the lobby area of the high school, you will turn in your rehearsal pass and get your hand marked to enter. Students may be taken to dressing rooms by females only. Performers must be in the dressing room 5 numbers prior to their performance on dress rehearsal day, and before the show begins for recitals. Please refer to the enclosed dance line-up order to ensure your child is dressed in the correct costume for their first dance. Only signed up volunteers with badges from me will be permitted in the dressing rooms and backstage. Helpers in rooms will help the smaller children dress. If you are able to help in the dressing room one night, sign up on the chart in the studio. Please understand if you sign up to help in a room, you need to **STAY THE ENTIRE TIME.** We are counting on you to help with all the children in that room, not just your child! The children stay in the dressing room until the finale, then parents should go to the room and help your child count and collect all of their things. Visitors are not allowed. Please wait to give flowers at the END. No reserved seats except for parents of seniors and staff. Bottled water, flowers and boutique gifts will be available for purchase.

DRESS REHEARSAL AND RECITAL CHECK LIST

- ✓ **GET A GOOD NIGHT'S SLEEP-** PLEASE KEEP IN MIND THAT APPEARING ON STAGE IN A RECITAL, BEFORE A LARGE AUDIENCE, IS QUITE AN EXPERIENCE. IT IS IMPORTANT THAT DANCERS ARE WELL RESTED AND RELAXED FOR REHEARSAL & RECITAL.
- ✓ **CHECK THAT YOU HAVE ALL YOUR COSTUME PIECES AND ACCESSORIES & REHEARSAL PASS.** DANCERS MUST BE FULLY DRESSED IN THE REQUIRED ATTIRE TO PERFORM ON STAGE. MAKE SURE YOU HAVE EVERYTHING!
- ✓ **PACK A BAG-** ITEMS OF NECESSITY; BOBBY PINS, SAFETY PINS, HAIRBRUSH AND A WATER BOTTLE OTHER POSSIBLE ITEMS: MAKEUP, HAIRBRUSH, HAIRSPRAY, CURLING IRON/STRAIGHTENER, IPOD WITH DANCE MUSIC (TO PRACTICE BACKSTAGE), GAMES/BOOKS (TO PASS THE TIME), A CHANGE OF CLOTHING FOR AFTER THE PERFORMANCE.
- ✓ **LABEL EVERYTHING WITH YOUR DANCER'S NAME- AND I MEAN EVERYTHING!** (SHOES, TIGHTS, HAIRBRUSH, GAMES, TOYS, ETC.)
- ✓ **HAIR-** ALL HAIR SHOULD BE NEATLY PULLED BACK AND WORK WELL WITH ANY HAIR ACCESSORIES. IF YOUR TEACHER HAS SPECIFIED A CERTAIN HAIR-DO WITH YOUR COSTUME PLEASE BE SURE TO HAVE HAIR READY ACCORDING TO THAT. NO EXTRA HAIR PIECES (OR JEWELRY) THAT DON'T GO WITH THE COSTUME.
- ✓ **MAKE-UP-** ALL DANCERS MUST WEAR MAKE-UP TO AVOID LOOKING WASHED OUT UNDER THE BRIGHT STAGE LIGHTS. LIPSTICK: DISTINCT RED (NOT PINK, ORANGE OR BROWNS), BLUSH: PINK OR RED, EYE SHADOW: SHADES OF BROWN, EYELINER: APPLY TO UPPER AND LOWER LIDS (UNNECESSARY FOR YOUNGER DANCERS.) MASCARA: BLACK
- ✓ **PUT ON COSTUME-** COME DRESSED AND READY IN YOUR 1st COSTUME.
- ✓ **ARRIVE PLENTY EARLY!** FOR DRESS REHEARSAL & RECITAL; AT LEAST 15 MINUTES BEFORE THE SHOW. WE WILL NOT BE ABLE TO WAIT FOR LATE DANCERS.
- ✓ **LOCATE DRESSING ROOM-** ROOM ASSIGNMENTS WILL BE POSTED IN THE LOBBY. ARRIVE NO EARLIER THAN 30 MIN. PRIOR TO THE SHOW. DANCERS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO DRESSING ROOMS UNTIL THEN. PARENTS SHOULD TAKE THEIR STUDENT TO THE DRESSING ROOM QUICKLY. ONLY BACKSTAGE VOLUNTEERS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE DRESSING ROOMS.
- ✓ **PICK YOUR CHILD UP AFTER THE FINALE- DO NOT PICK UP YOUR CHILD EARLY!** DANCERS MUST STAY IN DRESSING ROOMS UNTIL THE FINALE. AFTER THE FINALE, CHILDREN MAY BE PICKED UP BY FEMALES ONLY. DADS, BROTHERS, OR MALE FRIENDS/RELATIVES ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE DRESSING ROOM HALLWAY AT THE END OF THE SHOW. THE DRESSING ROOM AREA WILL BE ROPED OFF, AND YOU WILL NEED CLEARANCE TO RETRIEVE YOUR CHILD SO THAT WE DO NOT CONGEST THE AREA. IF YOUR CHILD DOESN'T HAVE A FEMALE TO PICK THEM UP, OUR STAFF WILL BE HAPPY TO BRING YOUR CHILD TO YOU.
